- 10.Staff and students should ensure social distancing guidelines and practice social responsibility.
- 11. Staff and students are advised to wear face masks when in campus.
- 12. No hostel occupancy shall be allowed at this stage.
- 13. Staff and students should always practice the precautionary measure as advised by the Ministry of Health, Negara Brunei Darussalam.

- 5. Classes or lectures can still be conducted online subject to the decision of the UNISSA.
- 6. The number of staff and students in the common area such as library, student café should continue to be monitored and controlled by limiting to 60% of the usual capacity.

OPERATIONAL LEVEL

- 7. Vulnerable staff and students or those who are showing sign of illness or symptoms are allowed to work from home/study at home subject to acknowledgement by the management of UNISSA.
- 8. Students are allowed to proceed with their internship programme locally. Declaration form is required to be filled in by student and the host of their internship programme.
- 9. Only important co-curricular activities and events could be held based on Risk Assessment report that must be approved by UNISSA Management.
- 10. Staff and students should continue to observe the social distancing guidelines and practice social responsibility.
- 11. The number of students permitted to stay at hostel is set to 30% from the setting limit of 60% at this stage.
- 12. Staff and students should always practice the precautionary measure as advised by the Ministry of Health, Negara Brunei Darussalam.

- 3. To continue provision of hand sanitiser at every checkpoints and common area such as Library, Staff and Student Centre, Lecture Theatres, Laboratories, Café, Canteen, etc.

- 5. Classes or lectures can still be conducted online subject to the decision of the UNISSA.
- 6. The number of staff and students in the common area such as library, student café should continue to be monitored and controlled by limiting to 80% of the usual capacity.



- 6. Vulnerable staff and students or those who are showing sign of illness or symptoms are allowed to work from home/study at home subject to acknowledgement by the management of UNISSA.
- 7. Students are allowed to proceed with their internship programme locally and declaration form is required to be filled in by student and the host of their internship programme.
- 8. Local field trips are allowed but subject to the UNISSA Management consideration. Declaration form is required to be filled in by student and the host / organizer.
- 9. Study abroad or similar programmes are allowed but limited to low risk countries and subject to the consideration of the UNISSA Management.
- 10. The number of students permitted to stay at hostel is set to 40% from the setting limit of 80% at this stage.
- 11. Staff and students should continue to observe the social distancing guidelines and practice social responsibility.
- 12. Co-curricular activities and events are allowed based on Risk Assessment report that must be approved by the UNISSA Management.
- 13. Staff and students should always practice the precautionary measure as advised by the Ministry of Health, Negara Brunei Darussalam.
